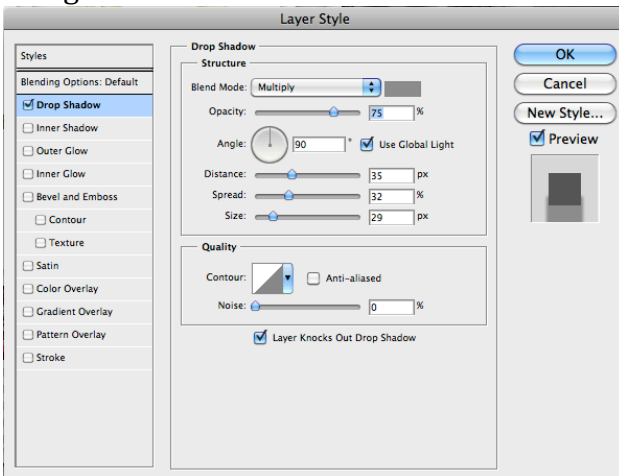
2. Go to the internet and find a interesting background. Save the image to your desktop. Open it up in Photoshop. You will be working with the **FILTER GALLERY**, you can also get there by clicking on Artistic and picking a filter under that menu. You will be changing the background. Take your time and play with all the different features. **LEARN**. Make sure to name the layer appropriately.



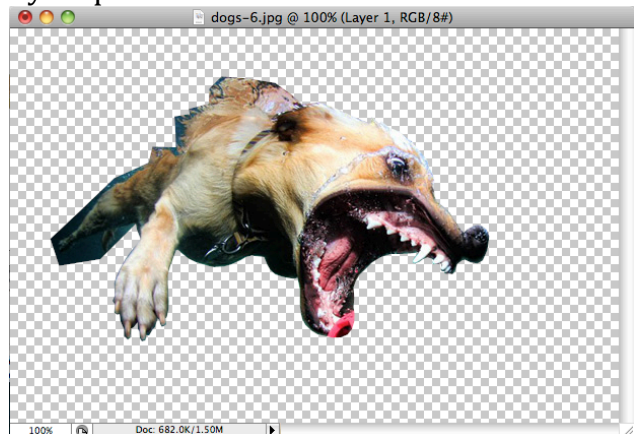
3. Create a new layer. Go to the internet and find a main subject. This subject needs to be detailed and a pain to cut out. **REMEMBER TO KEEP IT HIGH SCHOOL APPROPRIATE!!!!** Name it appropriately in your layers palette. You will need to use the lasso tools to cut it out. Try zooming in to help yourself.  $\mathbb{L}+$  or  $\mathbb{L}-$ . This will be your foreground.



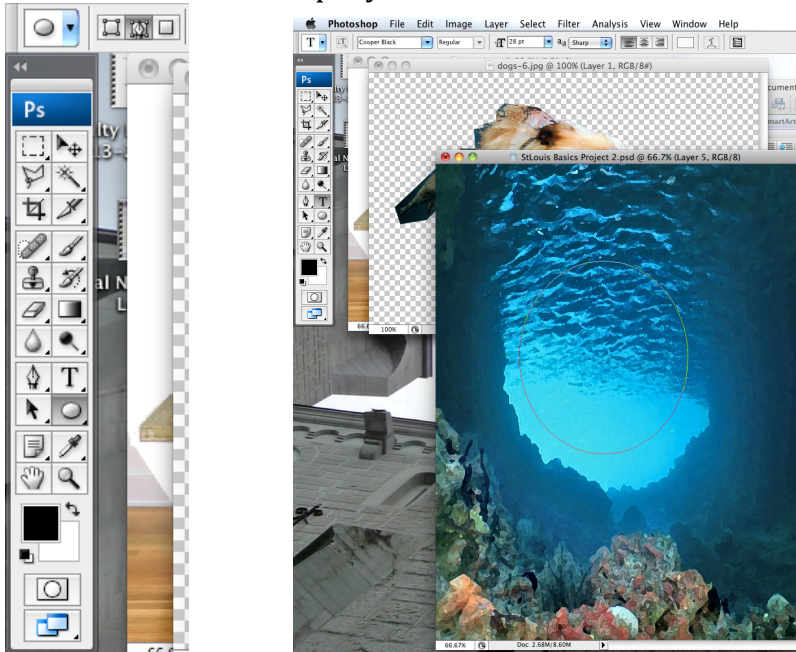
4. Double Click on the layer in the layers pallet. Notice all the fun things you can do. Add a shadow or a glow.



5. Next you will find another picture to interact with your main subject. Go through the same motions. Name each layer appropriately in your layers palette.



- Next you will use a shape tool with a text path to create text that goes in a shape. Find a shape that you want your text to follow. Next make sure the path selection is clicked. Create your shape. Then use the text button (T). Look for the I with a swoosh and click on the path. Type what you would like. Ask for help if you need it.



- Finally find some kind of shape, picture or object to fill in the middle ground.
